We want to act as a central resource and database for people who are prepared to help someone in need local to them and linking volunteers to those people in need when they need help.

The idea is that one volunteer per road will distribute these cut out cards and then in the future if someone in need contacts them then they can respond or request help from another volunteer if there is more than one per road.

The list on the website also acts as a resource for anyone needing help in the future who didn't receive a card or has lost it.

This is a very worrying time for all of us but we are hoping that as a community we can come together to help out neighbours in difficulty and we can all work together to get through this as smoothly as possible.
